## HAMPSTEAD & W MAINTAIN SIX POINT LEAD

Hampstead & Westminster won 4-3 at Buckingham to maintain both their one hundred per cent record and their six point lead at the top of the Vitality Women's Hockey League Premier Division table.

Amazingly, the game was goalless for the first 48 minutes before Jo Day gave Buckingham the lead in the 49th minute. Hampstead immediately replied in the same minute and they went ahead in the 51st minute, both goals scored by Lauren Turner. With the momentum with Hampstead, Melanie Wilkinson added a third goal in the 57th minute and Lucy Hyams a fourth with five minutes remaining, but Buckingham fought back, Natasha James scoring twice in the 66th and 70th minutes before Buckingham ran out of time to salvage a point and remain unbeaten. All three Premier Division meetings between the teams have been won by the away side.

Wimbledon took advantage of East Grinstead's week off to move into second with a 6-0 home thrashing of Beeston. Wimbledon led 5-0 at half time, Eliza Brett scoring twice with goals in the 5th and 17th minutes, Sarah Jones also notching a brace in the 21st and 26th minutes and Suzy Petty scoring in the 11th minute. The only goal of the second half came with two minutes remaining, Brett completing the first hat-trick in the Premier Division to join Hampstead's Turner as joint leading goalscorer on five goals.

Surbiton also moved above East Grinstead into third with a 4-1 win at the University of Birmingham, thanks to three second half goals. Leah Wilkinson gave Surbiton the perfect start in the third minute, only for Millie Giglio to level for the hosts in the 12th. Sophie Hamilton's double in the 47th and 61st minutes, either side of Maddie Long's goal in the 48th minute gave Surbiton their third successive win in Birmingham.

Loughborough Students moved off the bottom of the table with a narrow 1-0 home win over struggling Holcombe. Beth Alexander's 37th minute goal proved the difference between the sides as Loughborough won for the third time against Holcombe in four top flight meetings.

Last season, Clifton Robinsons won 3-0 at Swansea and in 2021-22 they returned to Wales and won again, this time 2-1. Ashley Mainwaring put Clifton ahead in the 7th minute with Claire Jones doubling the visitors' advantage two minutes before the break. Beth Wood gave Swansea hope two minutes into the second half, but Clifton secured their first win of the campaign, with Swansea dropping to the bottom of the table, a point behind Holcombe.

## HAMPSTEAD & W AIMING FOR SEVENTH SUCCESSIVE WIN

Leaders Hampstead & Westminster will be aiming to maintain their one hundred per cent record in the Vitality Women's Hockey League Premier Division when they host Holcombe on Saturday afternoon.

Hampstead have won all five games so far this season, but are currently on a six game winning streak which started with the final game of last season, a 1-0 win at Holcombe. Ironically, the game also saw the start of Holcombe's current six match run without a win following a 3-2 victory at Clifton Robinsons. History is with Hampstead, who have won all three league meetings, including a 7-1 home win in November 2019. Hampstead will be without Sarah Robertson and Emily Rowlands whilst Holcombe's Beth Bingham and Rose Thomas will also be at the World Cup qualifiers.

Second placed Wimbledon travel the short distance to Surbiton for a historic local derby under floodlights as the teams face each other in a league match for the first time. Surbiton will have to try and stay unbeaten without Leah Wilkinson and Robyn Collins and Wimbledon will need to compensate for Sarah Jones and Sarah-Jayne Thorburn who are all on World Cup qualifier duty.

East Grinstead return from a second week off after a bye week, having also fallen behind with their fixtures after competing in Europe. Like Surbiton and Wimbledon, East Grinstead have never faced Swansea before, due to East Grinstead playing in the Conference East and Swansea in the Conference West before East Grinstead won promotion to the top flight. Swansea haven't won this season and with Ella Jackson joining East Grinstead's Jo Westwood in the World Cup qualifiers, will find their task slightly harder in West Sussex.

Clifton Robinsons are at home to Loughborough Students and are the only two teams from Loughborough's first-ever season in the Premier Division in 2000-01, currently in the top division. Both teams won their first league match of the season, Clifton at Swansea and Loughborough at home to Holcombe. Loughborough have never beaten Clifton in six

historic meetings but will be hopeful, even without the services of Charlotte Watson as Clifton will have to cope without Izzy Webb, Livvy Hoskins and Phoebe Richards.

Beeston will be missing Sophie Robinson when they travel to the University of Birmingham for a Midlands derby. Beeston will be hoping for a change of fortune having lost on their last three visits to Birmingham after winning in 2013. The University of Birmingham are a point ahead of Beeston after four matches, but neither team is in form, Beeston having lost their last three games and the University of Birmingham losing their last two.

## Surbiton v Wimbledon

Sugden Road - 1800

### First meeting

Surbiton have never faced Wimbledon in a league competition before. Surbiton made their league debut in 1990-91 in the Surrey Ladies League, while Wimbledon were members of the national league until 2006-07. The teams nearly met in the South Clubs' Women's Hockey League as Wimbledon were on the way down at the same time that Surbiton were on the way up.

Wimbledon were relegated from SCWHL Division One in 2008-09, the same season that Surbiton were promoted from SCWHL Division Two and that is the closest that the teams have come until last season when only the curtailed league season preventing them playing each other in the Premier Division.

Surbiton did play Wimbledon 1A in SCWHL Division Two in 2007-08, Surbiton drawing 1-1 at Sugden Road and winning 6-1 at King's College School.
