SURBITON AND WIMBLEDON IN BATTLE FOR EUROPE

Surbiton and Wimbledon meet at Sugden Road on Saturday night when Surbiton need to win to keep their hopes of another season in Europe alive. Wimbledon, holding a five point advantage of their local rivals with just two games remaining, need just a draw to join champions, Old Georgians in Europe next season.

Both matches between Surbiton and Wimbledon ended in draws earlier this season, Surbiton needing two late goals from Luke Taylor to snatch a 2-2 draw at home in November, whilst in the return fixture at Raynes Park High School, it was Wimbledon who mounted a comeback, a David Condon brace and Ed Horler's late equaliser earning a thrilling 5-5 draw.

Also on Saturday night, Hampstead & Westminster host East Grinstead as they try and hold off Holcombe for a fourth place finish. East Grinstead, who pipped Oxted to the final Top Six place, have struggled in the second half of the season, earning a single point from their last eight games. East Grinstead have lost their last five games and Hampstead haven't had the best of form either, winning one and losing five of their last six games, the win coming in a 4-1 victory at East Grinstead in March. Hampstead also beat East Grinstead in their first meeting of the season, 4-2 in London.

On Sunday, Old Georgians head to Holcombe, where they won 2-1 in October. In the reverse fixture in March, Old Georgians put Holcombe to the sword, winning 8-2 as their full attacking potential was on display. Holcombe are battling with Hampstead for fourth place but could find the final positions all but decided if they lost to Old Georgians and Hampstead beat East Grinstead.

OLD GEORGIANS CLINCH THEIR MAIDEN TITLE

Old Georgians clinched their first-ever Men's Hockey League Premier Division title with a 5-0 win at East Grinstead on Saturday night. Old Georgians led 4-0 at half time, Tom Carson opening the scoring in the 15th minute from a penalty corner, Edward Carson doubled the visitors' lead from open play a minute later and James Tindall and James Carson also converting penalty corners in the 22nd and 32nd minutes. Tindall added his second goal from open play with five minutes to play.

Surbiton and Wimbledon are battling for the second European qualification place, with Wimbledon in pole position with a five point advantage over Surbiton with two games to play. Surbiton host Wimbledon next Saturday night and both teams will go into the match in excellent form. Wimbledon beat Hampstead & Westminster 5-1, Sam Hooper giving Wimbledon a fourth minute lead from a penalty corner, before Matt Guise-Brown equalised, also from a penalty corner five minutes later. Ed Horler restored Wimbledon's lead from the penalty spot in the 18th minute, before Hooper scored his second goal of the match two minutes before half time, again from a penalty corner.

Horler added to Wimbledon's 3-1 half time lead with a 44th minute penalty corner conversion and a 65th minute open play goal to put the pressure on Surbiton in the race for Europe.

Surbiton responded with an even larger margin of victory, putting Holcombe to the sword with a 7-1 home win, with Luke Taylor and Gareth Furlong converting penalty corners in the second and fifth minutes as Holcombe were caught cold early.

Tim Guise-Brown pulled a goal back from a penalty corner in the 13th minute, but after that it was all Surbiton with Jamie Golden scoring Surbiton's third goal from open play in the 22nd minute and Taylor scoring his 20th goal of the campaign with another penalty corner conversion in the 29th minute.

Holcombe trailed 6-1 at the end of the third quarter, Rob Farrington scoring in the 42nd minute and Ben Park netting in the 50th minute, both goals coming from open play before Alex Williams completed the rout with another open play goal in the penultimate minute.

EXETER BATTLE WITH DURHAM TO AVOID DROP

In the Bottom 5, the relegation battle could take another twist after Durham University lost 2-1 at Brooklands Manchester University to remain in jeopardy. The University of Exeter, who seemed to be in the ascendancy after two wins over Durham, were sent back to the bottom of the table after drawing at Oxted, whilst Durham were beating Beeston. Exeter return after their second bye week to host Beeston for the first time in Devon this season after losing twice in Nottingham, 3-1 in November and 3-2 in February. Exeter, two points behind Durham with a game in hand, can move back off the bottom if they can beat a Beeston team which has lost their last three games, 2-1 against Brooklands, 1-0 against Durham and 4-0 at home to Oxted last weekend.

Durham have their second bye week as Brooklands visit Oxted, the teams having drawn 4-4 in Surrey in November before Oxted stunned the Manchester club by winning 6-2 in the North West in March. Brooklands win over Durham last weekend moved them a point above Beeston into eighth place with a game in hand.

DURHAM UNIVERSITY LOSE AT BROOKLANDS

In the Bottom 5, Durham University wasted a chance to pull away from the University of Exeter at the bottom of the table, after they went down 2-1 at Brooklands Manchester University. Luis Cuttle put Brooklands ahead from a 16th minute penalty corner, but although Christian DeAngelis levelled in the 26th minute, again from a penalty corner, David Flanagan scored Brooklands' winner from open play on the half hour mark.

The victory moved Brooklands above Beeston into eighth after Oxted cemented their seventh place with a convincing 4-0 win in Nottingham. Jamie Batten's 21st and Lewis Fraser's 27th minute penalty corner conversions gave Oxted a 2-0 half time lead. In the second half, Jordan Turnbull and Rafa Calderon both scored from open play in the 40th and 62nd minutes to complete a miserable day for Beeston, who failed to score for the second successive match.

These matches were the first Men's Hockey League Premier Division games played in the month of April since Southgate lost 6-0 at home to East Grinstead on 4 April 2013.
